4. Two letters of recommendation from academic advisor, counselor or a professional individual familiar with your background and skills. Letters should include (a) how long and in what capacity the reference has known the applicant; (b) description of applicant's academic accomplishments, leadership qualities, and extracurricular activities.
5. Proof of enrollment of a federally-recognized Tribe or Nation (Certificate of Indian Blood or enrollment card).
